



Mondays: The Bread and Butter Thing



What does it cost? Anyone can sign up for £4 (individual); £7.50 (family) or £15 (large family) per week.

Where is it? Sale West Community Centre When is it? Mondays at 1.30 p.m.

Once registered, you simply text 'YES' by 10.00 a.m. on a Sunday and collect your food the next day at 1.30 p.m.

First order is free of charge and there is no long term commitment.

How do I sign up? To register, <u>text</u> (please don't call) your full name, postcode and 'Sale West' to **07984 356407**.

Fridays: Food Share

Food Share is open to anyone and is completely free of charge just bring a bag! The scheme is designed to prevent waste by offering food which is at its 'sell by' date and would otherwise go to landfill. Food comes from local supermarkets like M&S, Tesco, Co-op and Aldi and is of very good quality. First come, first served!

Tuesdays: Food Bank

You will need a voucher to access this service and certain conditions apply. Free supplies include food and beverages. Items such as toiletries and cleaning products are often available but depend upon donations. The food bank is open



at Sale West Youth Centre on Tuesdays from 11.00 a.m. -1.00.p.m.

Weekdays: Good Food Bag

Many of you will have enjoyed The Good Food Bag scheme over the summer but it doesn't have to stop there. You can



pre-order via text on 07780 843821 and pick up at the Sunshine Café on weekdays. Collect a bag on your way home from the school run and that's your tea sorted!

The meal kits contain everything you need to make a meal for a family of four and an easy-to-follow recipe - all for just £7. That's £1.75 per portion!

Food Facts and Figures!

We are thrilled to report that, since Christmas 2020, we have provided around 15,000 free

meals for local children during school holidays. We have also helped local families and vulnerable residents through the various food schemes. These have come in the form of actual cooked meals, meal kits and food vouchers.

Regular pickups to local supermarkets such as Tesco, Co-op, Aldi and M&S have resulted in the provision of the equivalent of *50,000 meals* during that period, saving around *20,000Kg* of food going to landfill, not to mention a CO₂ saving of around 56,000Kg!

Not only is this providing a great service to local people, but we are doing our bit to reduce the impact of global warming. As they say, every little helps!



Our Sale West Plans for the Future ...

As you know, Our Sale West Big Local was awarded £1m in 2015 to be spent over 10 years to make a lasting and positive difference to our community. Using your ideas, we are now planning for our final years up to 2025 and here are some of the projects we have in mind, listed under each of our aims:

- **Health and Wellbeing:** Continue with trips and events/leisure courses/opportunities to meet up such as 'Sporting Memories', 'Strictly Lunch'/food provision and waste reduction/links with outside agencies
- **Environment and Community Spaces:** Continue with plans for the new Community Centre/develop the park and growing spaces/create a 'Friends Of' group to help look after the estate/create a tree trail.
- **Youth:** Continue to offer Friday night Youth Club provision/provide holiday food and activities/work with local schools/stage events to engage young people.
- ♦ **Employment and Training:** Continue to provide job advice, help and support/offer Community Grants for local entrepreneurs/work with local providers, e.g. Job Centre, Citizens Advice/offer training courses through local providers.

We are already planning our legacy once the Our Sale West Big Local ceases to exist in 2025. Over the next couple of years, we will set up a new Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), so that the good work of Our Sale West can continue well into the future.
